On May 24, 2011 a special meeting was held to brainstorm solutions to our safety concerns at the OV Saturday Swap meet.

Galen Lutz, board president of HRRMC opened the meeting with a statement of purpose, expectations of meeting conduct and a short video stating some of the safety concerns. He then turned the meeting over to Celine Lowe to facilitate the brainstorming for solutions to the safety issues.

The exchange was rich and respectful. The HPD and HFD were complimented on the manner in which they've assisted, from their initial involvement, with the safety concerns.. Both Dennis Smith and Mr. Peebles demonstrated a great willingness to work with us toward solving the issues in a win/win manner.

After all the ideas were charted, the members present were given 3 stickers to put on their top priorities. They could spend all of them on one solution or divide them out.

Following are the agreed upon solutions in priority order from the members present:

### **Solutions**

- Mr. Peebles will finance the bulldozing of an additional parking area for the SWAP Meet parking and will hire special services to assist in enforcement for the first 2 weeks. (12 votes)
- Dennis Smith will provide signage for overflow parking. (7 votes)

- The members wanted a center line painted down PK to designate correct sides and a pedestrian crosswalk may be necessary. (6 votes)
- Police to continue their involvement with parking enforcement (5 votes)
- Traffic control persons with vests to assist and direct traffic (2 votes)
- Speeding cars and water hauling trucks should be ticketed. (2 votes)
- Work with private owners to enforce trespassing laws for the illegal vending (2 votes)

**Other solutions that did not receive any votes were:**

- Place barricades along road to prevent illegal parking PD would have to help prevent theft
- Verbally tell of tickets before enforcing
