It was discussed how HRRMC would be putting either large rocks or some kind of barricade at the end of each road.

Owners of lots with junk cars on easements will be notified to move them. Also HRRMC needs to check with the county as to the safety and liability of lots with trash. Will check into lots, write letter to clean up or get community to offer to clean up. If no respond.... will call Planning Commission or Health Dept. they could eventually fine up to \$500 if it poses a health hazard. HRRMC cannot enforce. Mats said there is a web site with a form were residents can send e-mail and make comments on concerns etc....

Also told how members can pay their fee with paypal.

Someone asked about number of properties and residents. Don stated the number of properties, about 1200. It is not known how many residents. Micky volunteered to go around and count. There are 54 miles of roads.

Don remarked on road work done so far this year and said more is planned for next year.

Ann asked about 4 way stops on Jacaranda, wanted to know what was the advantaged to having them. She thinks it is more dangerous to have them as people just ignore them from both directions and go through. With only one road having a stop, there will be less risk for an accident.

Board needs to work with the County Traffic Office before removing any signs.
